Saturday, **June 10**, **2023** – The term "moving day" certainly lived up to its name on Saturday at the RBC Canadian Open. <u>Nick Taylor shot the composite-course record</u> after firing a 9-under 63 to lead the Canadian contingent and sit three shots back of leader, C.T. Pan.

Taylor recorded nine birdies during his round including five on the front nine to shoot a 31. He continued his momentum by opening and closing the back nine with birdies to take the early clubhouse lead at Oakdale Golf and Country Club.

Pan booked himself a spot in Sunday's final pairing with Tommy Fleetwood after shooting a 6-under 66 which included a strong finish with back-to-back birdies on 17 and 18, finishing with seven on the day. Pan currently sits at -14 and holds a two-shot lead over a group of six golfers which includes: Fleetwood, two-time defending champion Rory McIlroy, Mark Hubbard, Justin Rose, Harry Higgs and Andrew Novak.
