Q. Seen the course a few times now. Do you think you'll adjust anything or you're happy with the way things have been going?

LINNEA STROM: I think I'll just kind of keep the same game plan. Obviously it will be fun to see if they move some tees around. Might be a little bit different.

I'm pretty comfortable how the course is playing. A lot of holes suit my eye out here. Yeah, I mean, I have my dad here and host housing out supporting me. I feel like I have a big crew following me and cheering me on which has been amazing.

They gave me some energy today for sure.

So I really enjoyed that. So I'm just going to enjoy the weekend and kind of had a tough year so far, so to play the



weekend I'm just very excited about it because I really miss this.
